SHOWERS

Not only is there is a shower enclosure solution for every style and size of bathroom, from contemporary frameless walk-ins to more decorative options, you can also position a shower almost anywhere in the bathroom – so long as your plumbing allows it. A corner is an obvious choice, but fitting a shower in an alcove is also a possibility.

The traditional shower has always been a square tray surrounded by glass panels and a door, which slots snugly into a corner. This still works fine, but there are many other options available, too.

WALK-IN SHOWERS

The popularity of the walk-in and walk-through shower has grown significantly, driven by our desire to achieve a wet-room look without the expense of tanking the floor and walls. Comprising a simple glass panels teamed with a low-profile or concealed underfloor shower tray

RECESSED SHOWER ENCLOSURES

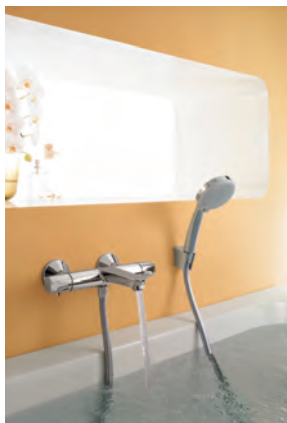
A recessed shower enclosure that fits between walls is an excellent solution for bathrooms, leaving the rest of the floor space free for other bathroom furniture. With the walls already in place, the only consideration needed is the type of shower screen preferred – fully enclosed or walk-in.



QUADRANT SHOWER ENCLOSURES

Quadrant enclosures are a great space-saving alternative to rectangular or square corner enclosures, taking the shape of a quarter circle, with either two sides of the same length and an offset option. These normally come with either 1 or 2 sliding doors.

FURNITURE

Bathroom furniture has become No. 1 on our clients' wish lists...

Most bathrooms or en-suites are lacking storage solutions. Bathworks offer a range of solutions to provide more cupboard space.

FITTED FURNITURE

This can be a great solution for storage, as well as concealing any unsightly pipework. The fitted furniture can give you a seamless basin and work top option, giving you a much larger surface area.

Work tops can be supplied in a solid surface, incorporating a basin moulded into a one piece top. The solid surface material allows for shapes and sizes not available in ceramic options.

MODULAR FURNITURE

Modular has now become the most popular option, as clients want to achieve that 'hotel' look. It allows individual pieces to be placed almost anywhere in the bathroom without the restrictions of fitted furniture.

It can be either freestanding or wall hung and come with either drawers or doors. Many units come as standard with soft close doors or drawers for that real feeling of good quality.

WASHBASINS

Probably the biggest option within the bathroom range products. Basins can be wall mounted, pedestal option, compact and corner versions.

If you can fit a basin into your bathroom space, the probability is Bathworks can supply a storage unit to sit under your basin.

Bathworks can offer a vast range of basins, also sit on bowls and furniture basins. It is important to match a small basin to suitable brassware.



There are various options for toilets, depending on location and the space available.

WALL HUNG TOILETS

A wall-mounted toilet is hung on a concealed frame, allowing a flooring to run underneath the pan. The cistern and frame are concealed behind boxing or a piece of bathroom furniture.

This creates a feeling of space, and makes the room easier to clean. An ideal choice for any bathrooms, en-suites and cloakrooms.

BACK-TO-WALL TOILETS (FLOOR STANDING)

A back-to-wall WC is designed to maximise space within the bathroom and present a sleek finish. Back-to-wall toilet pans are placed against a furniture unit or bathroom boxing, this can be tiled to blend in with the rest of the room. Concealing the cistern and piping allows for clean, minimalist lines and increased floor space.

CLOSE-COUPLED TOILETS

The most well known of toilet options, consists of a cistern that sits directly on top of the pan, which is then fitted to the floor.

A close-coupled toilet is a complete unit. The pipes connecting the cistern to the bowl are concealed within the toilet, giving it a sleek finish.



Choice ranges from streamlined, contemporary toilets, to traditional designs with period detail.

COMBINATION SHOWER TOILETS

New combined toilets/bidets offer a new standard of cleanliness, redefining comfort and hygiene.

Water jets can be adjusted to individual preferences from a simple remote control or by the touch of a button.



TILES

Bathworks have some fantastic bathroom tile ideas for any size bathroom area.

Bathroom tile sizes vary from tiny mosaic tiles to gigantic tiles which can reach meters in length.

With tiles there are no rules as to sizing or how you set out your tiles. Landscape/portrait and brickbond are some of the options using rectangular tiles.

Don't be afraid to use large tiles in a small room, bathroom tiles measuring 600mm x 300mm are now very common. Large tiles do work in a small en-suite or cloakroom.

There's plenty to choose from allowing you to get the perfect style, a variety of tiling patterns can be made to help enhance your room.
